

## About Johnson Bible College

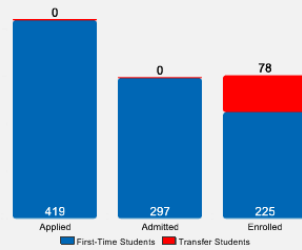

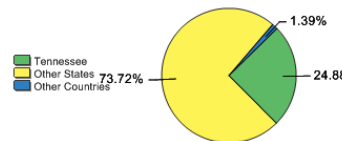

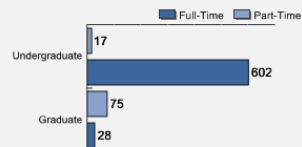

### Freshman Class Geographical Profile



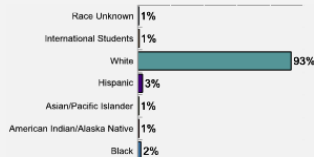

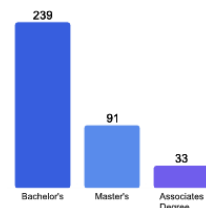

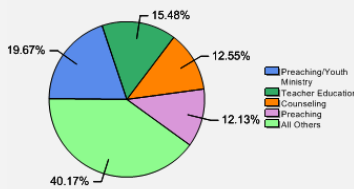

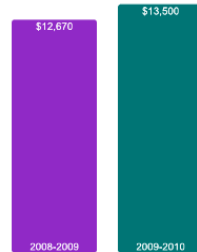
