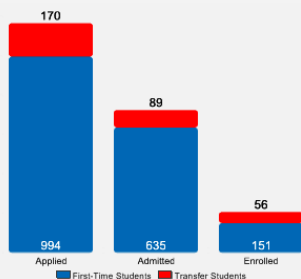

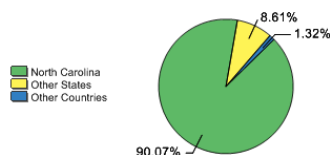

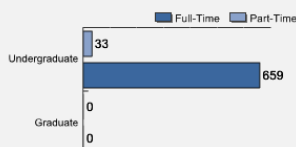

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



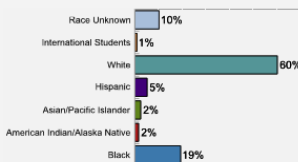

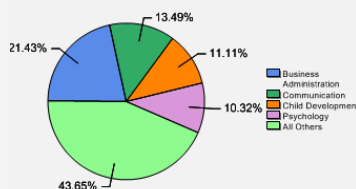

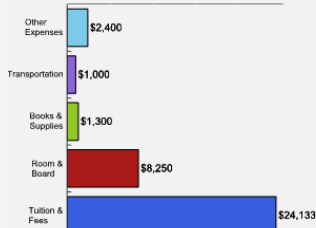

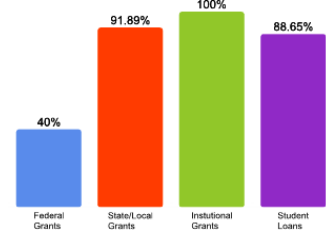

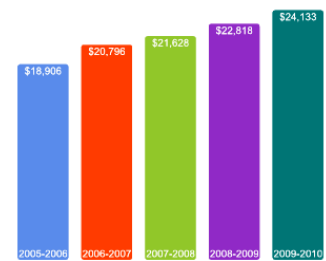
