

## About Stanford University

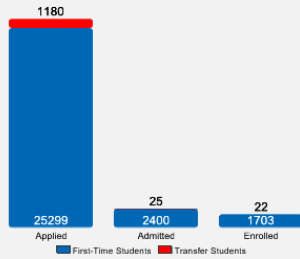

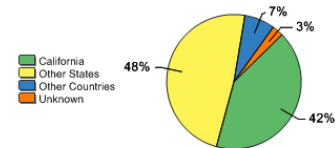

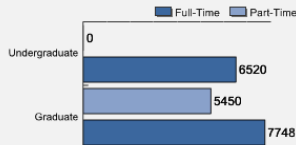

### Freshman Class Geographical Profile



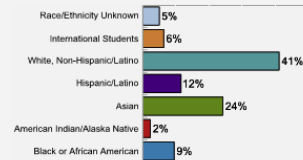

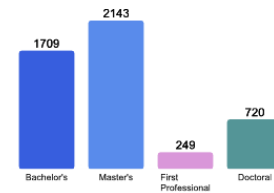

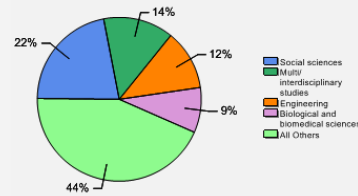

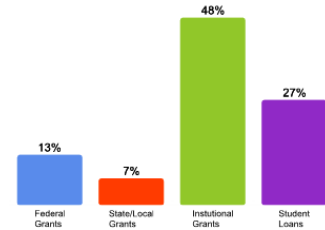
## What Students Pay

\* Net tuition for each individual student may be lower or higher depending on family income and student eligibility and availability of grant aid.

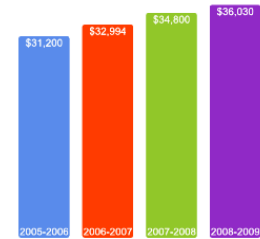
