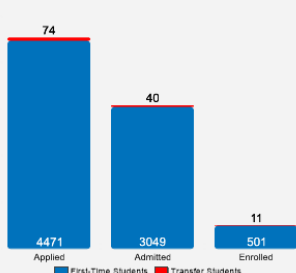

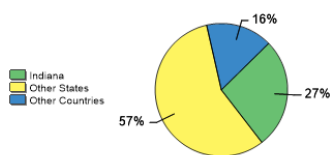

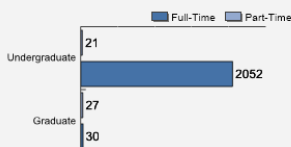

Fall 2018 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



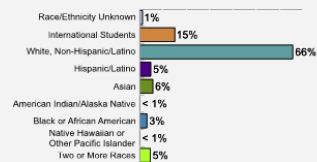
Fall 2018 Enrollment

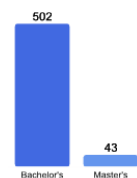

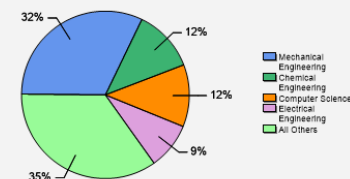

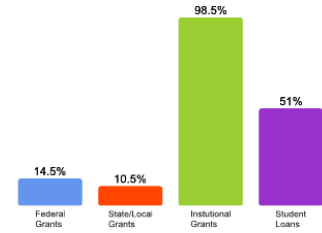

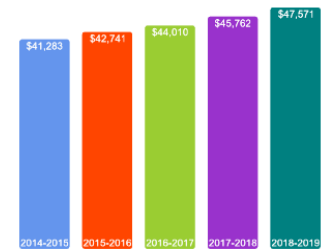
