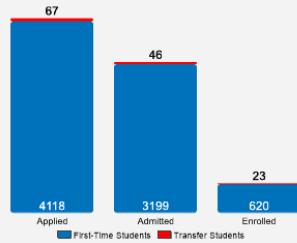

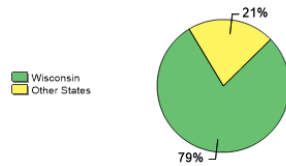

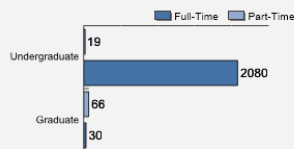

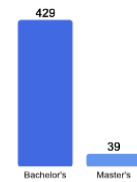

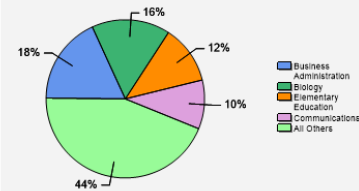

Bachelor's Degrees Awarded Last Year



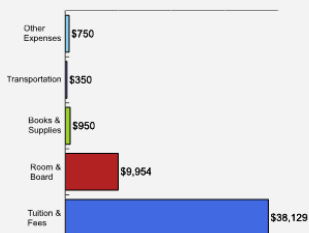

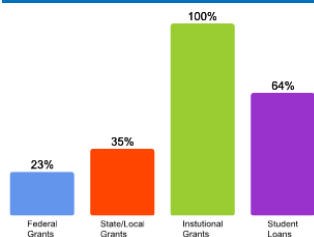

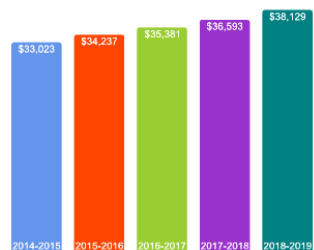
