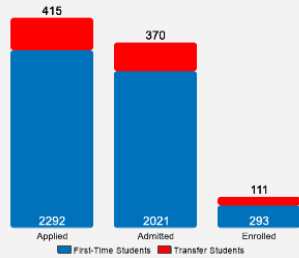

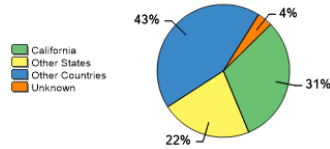

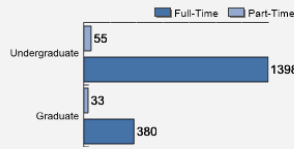


Average High School GPA of Freshman Class: 3.3

Fall 2018 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



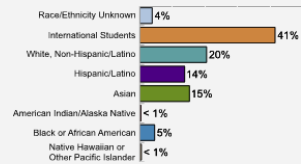
Fall 2018 Enrollment

Percentage of Students Who Graduate

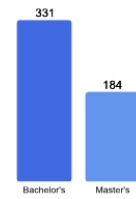

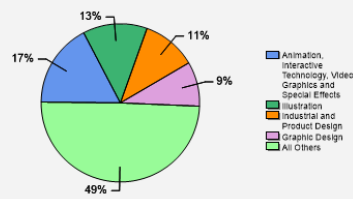

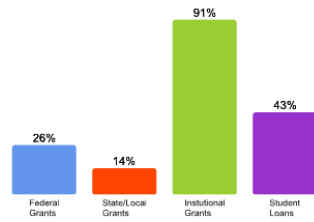

#### Percent of Freshmen Receiving Aid by Type



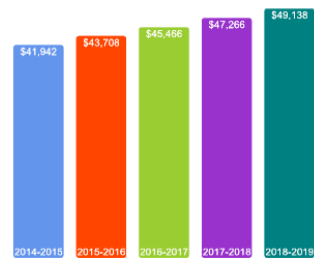

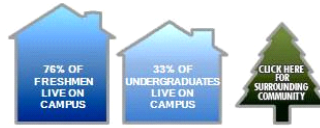
