

About California College of the Arts

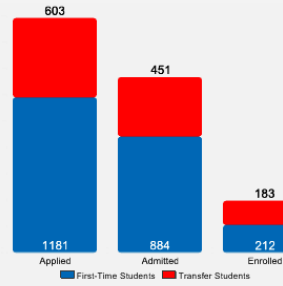

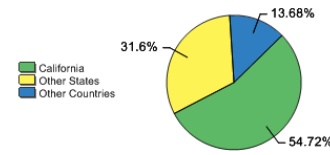

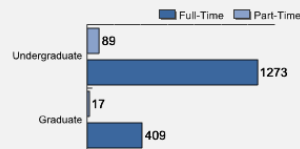

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



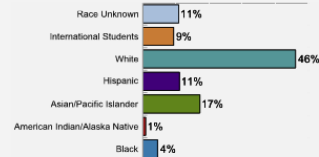

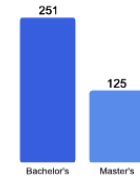
* CCA's Bachelor of Fine Arts degree is 126 units and the Bachelor of Architecture degree is 165 units, a five-year degree program.

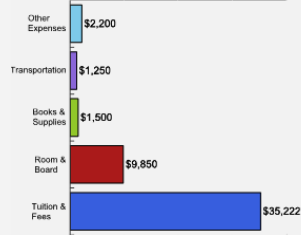

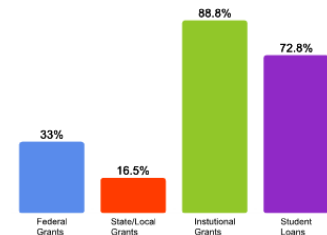

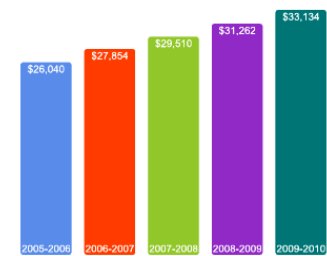
