

About Bridgewater College

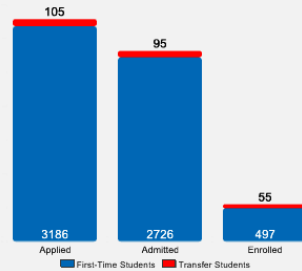

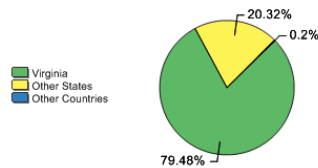

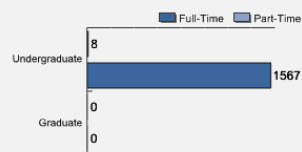

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



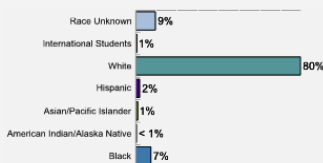

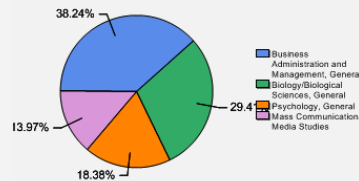

Bachelor's Degrees Awarded Last Year



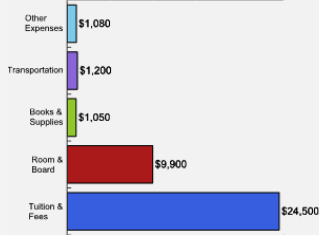

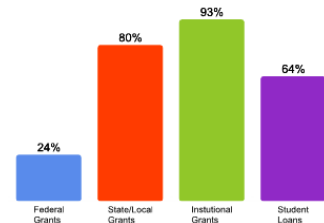

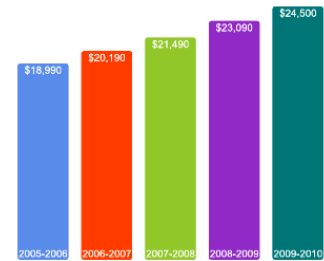
