

About Bridgewater College

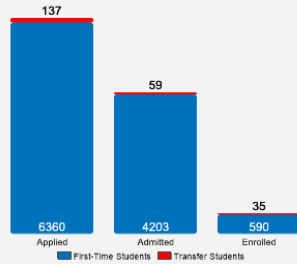

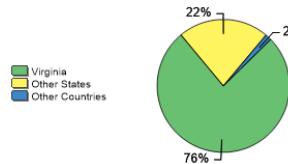

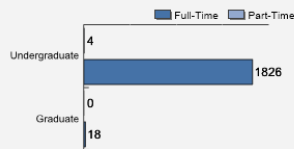

Fall 2018 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



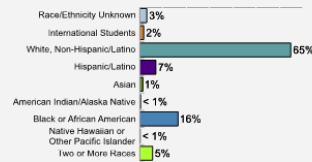
Fall 2018 Enrollment

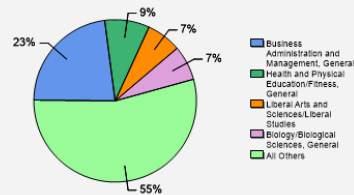

Bachelor's Degrees Awarded Last Year

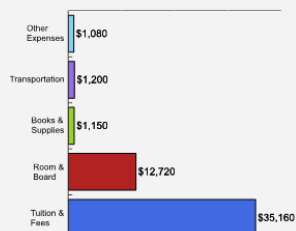

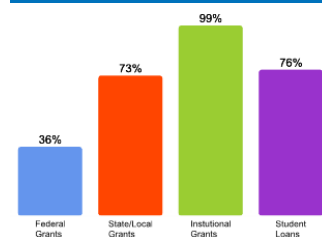


What Students Pay

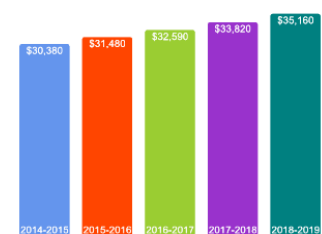
