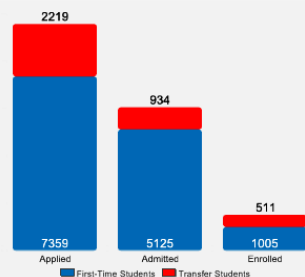

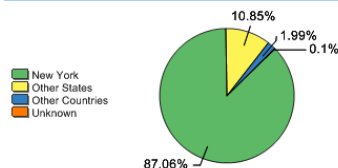

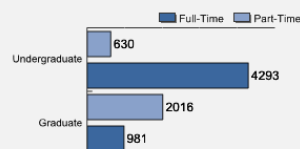

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



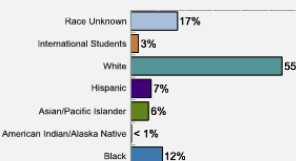

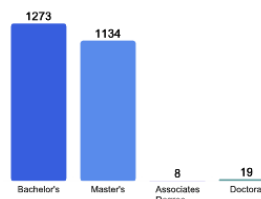

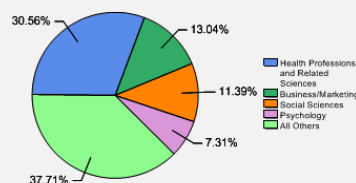

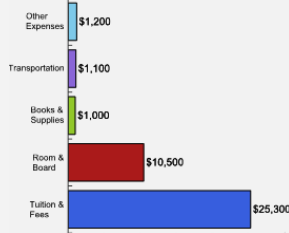

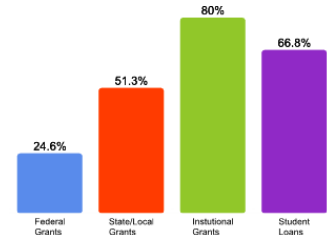

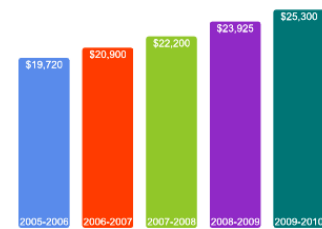
