

About Alverno College

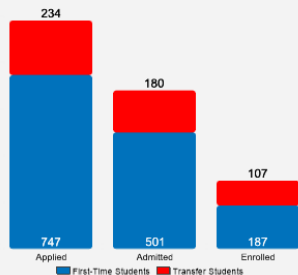

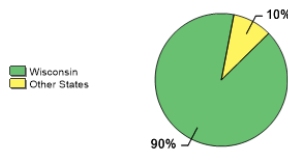

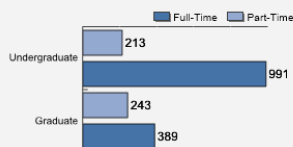

Fall 2018 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



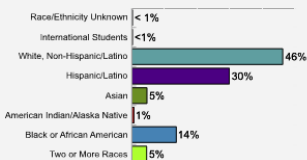
Fall 2018 Enrollment

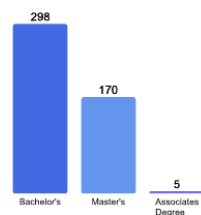

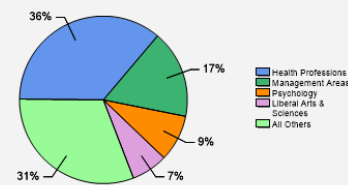

Bachelor's Degrees Awarded Last Year



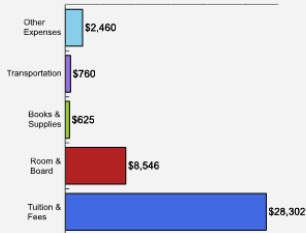

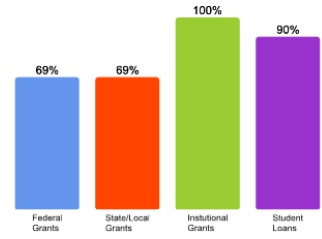

Percent of Freshmen Receiving Aid by Type



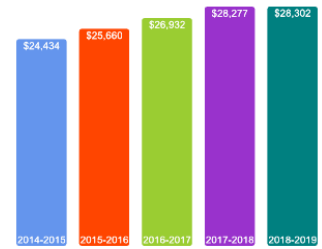

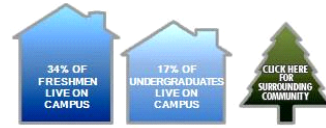
