

**About Cotley College**

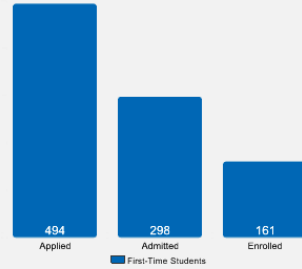

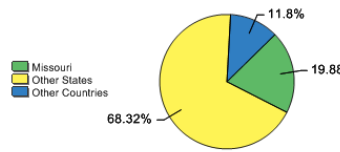

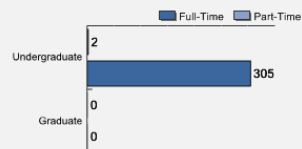

**Freshman Class Geographical Profile**



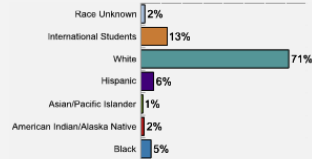

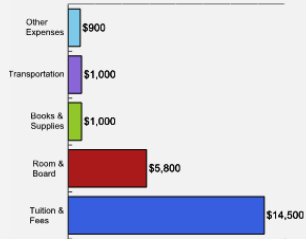

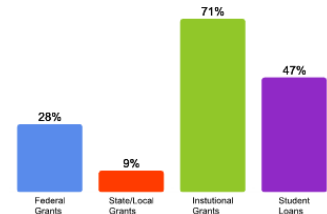


What it's Like on Our Campus

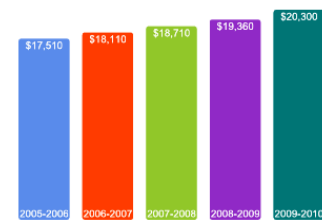
Campus Safety
