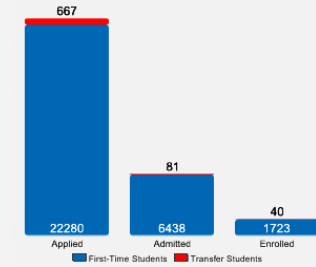

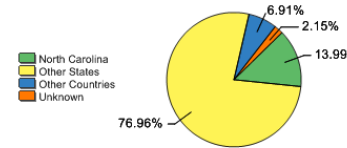

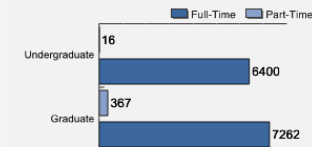

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



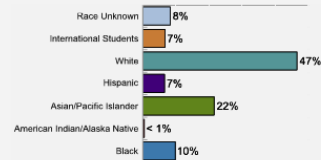

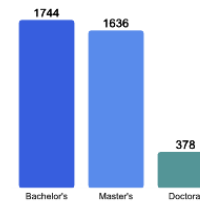

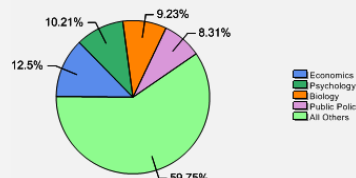

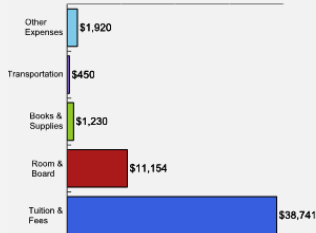

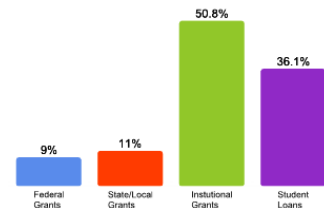

Percent of Freshmen Receiving Aid by Type



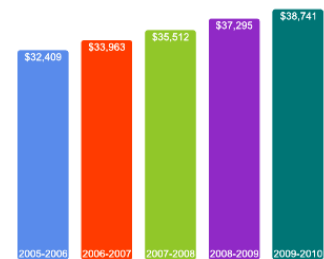
2008 Average Net Tuition for Aided Undergraduates * **\$7,851**
