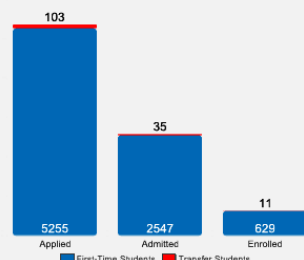

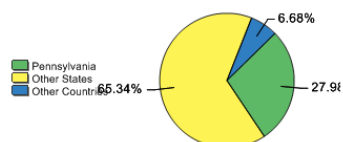

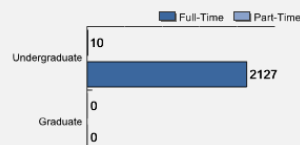

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



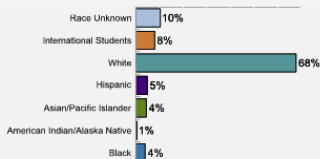
Enrollment

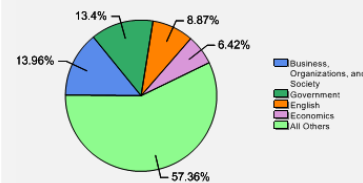

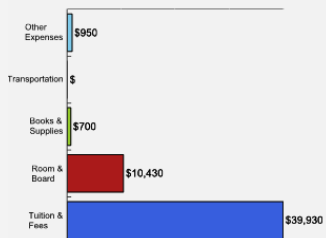

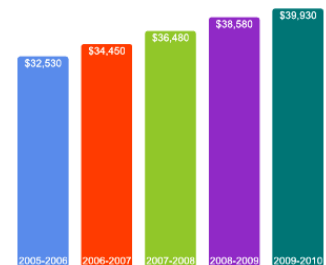
