

About Free Will Baptist Bible College

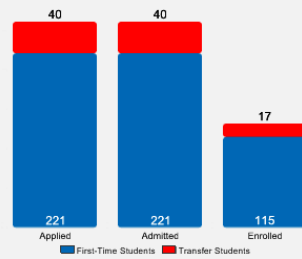

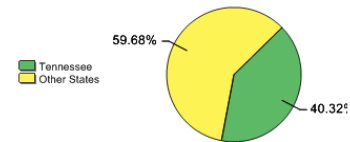

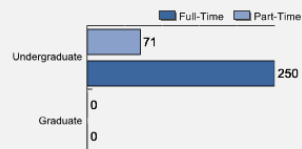

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



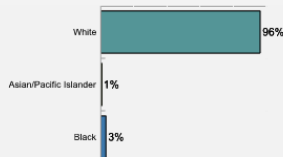

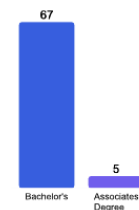

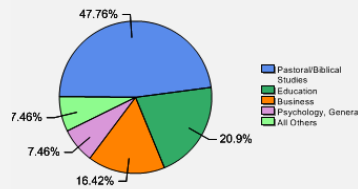

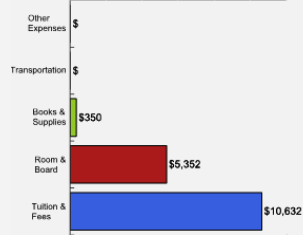

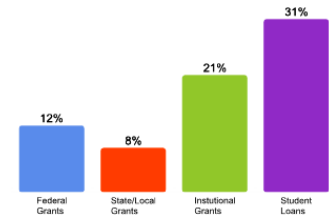

What Students Pay

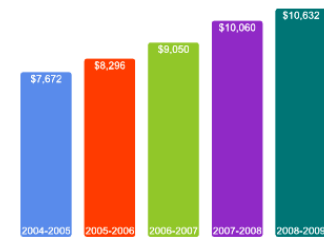
Price of Attendance in 2008-09
