

About Greensboro College

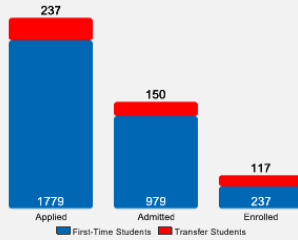

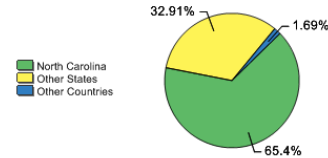

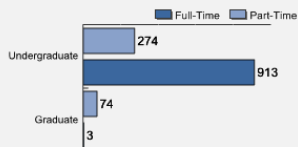

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



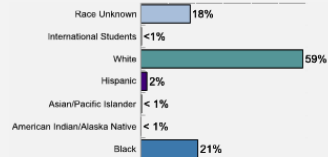

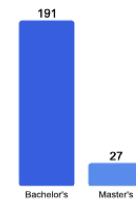

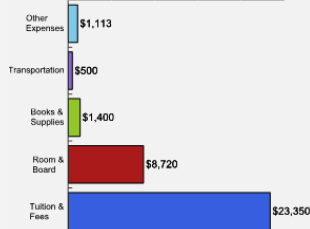
