

## About Grinnell College

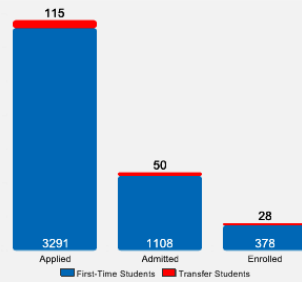

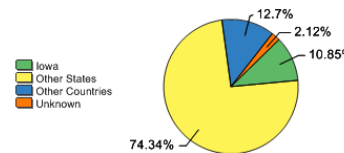

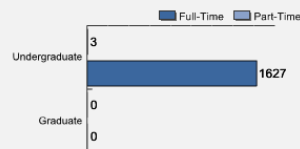

### Freshman Class Geographical Profile



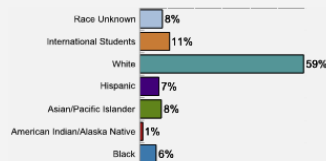

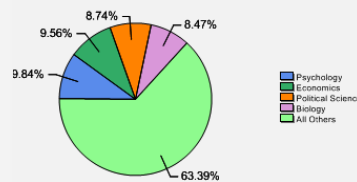

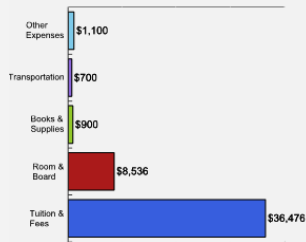

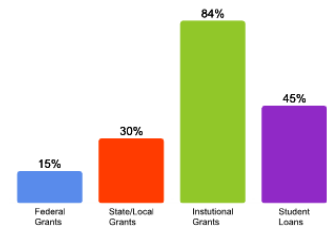

### 2008 Average Net Tuition for Aided Undergraduates \*

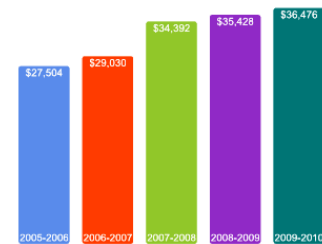
