

## About Johns Hopkins University

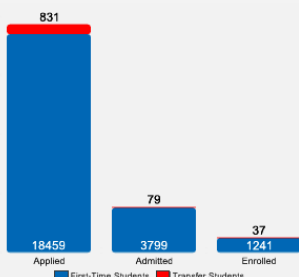

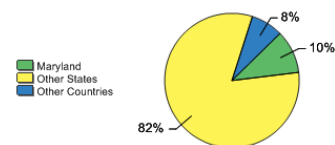

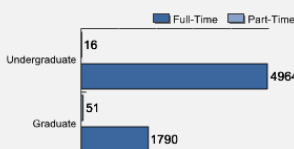

### Fall 2010 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



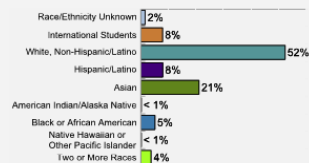
### Fall 2010 Enrollment

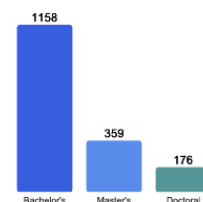

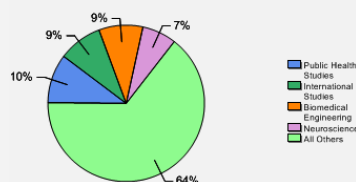

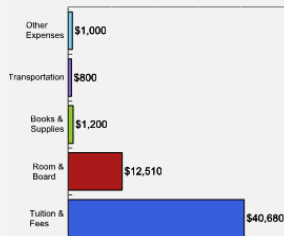

Price of Attendance in 2010-11

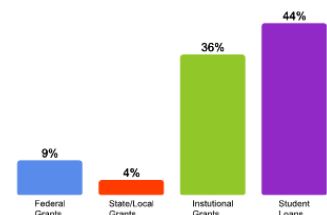


What it's Like on Our Campus

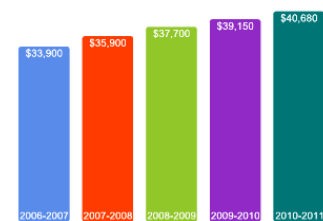
