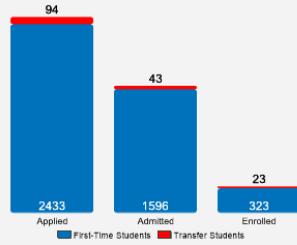

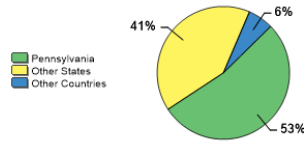

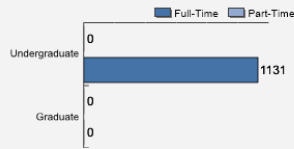

Fall 2018 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



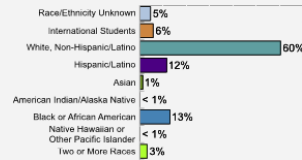
Fall 2018 Enrollment

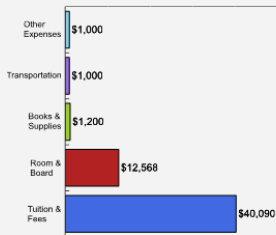

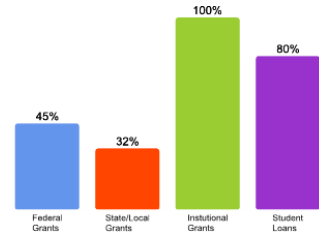

Price of Attendance in 2018-19



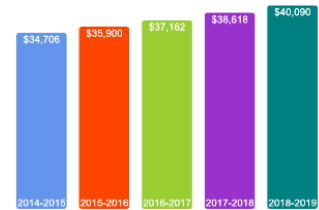
Percent of Freshmen Receiving Aid by Type

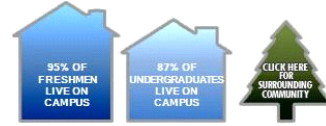
