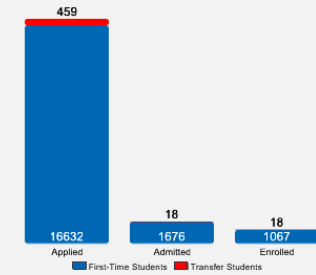

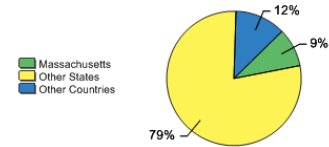

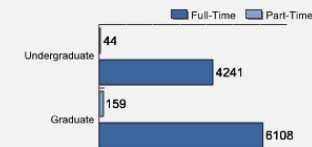

Fall 2010 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



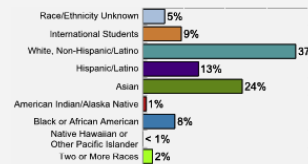
Fall 2010 Enrollment

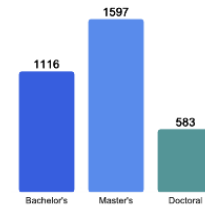

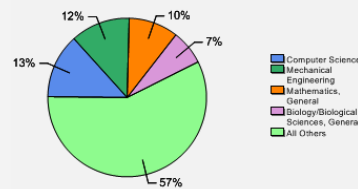

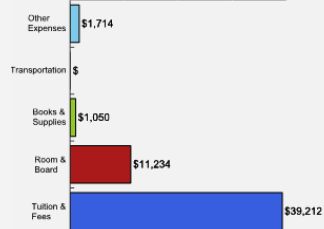

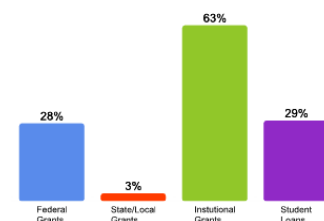

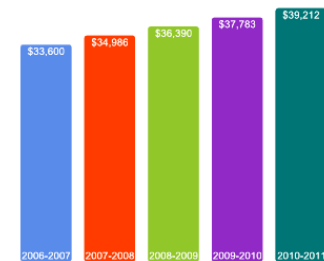
