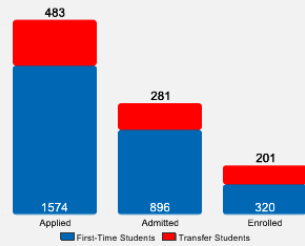

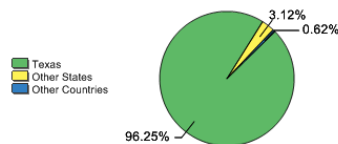

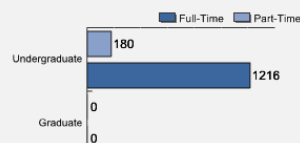

### Freshman Class Geographical Profile



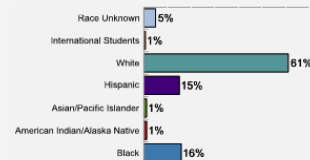

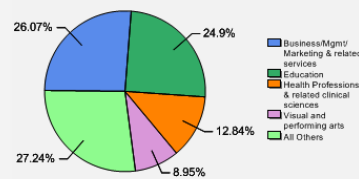

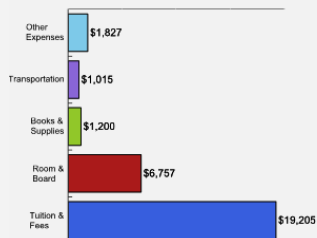

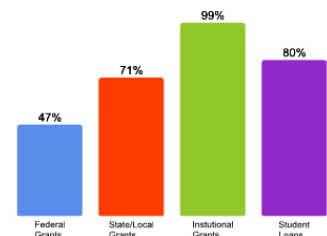

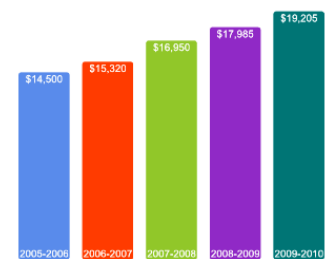
