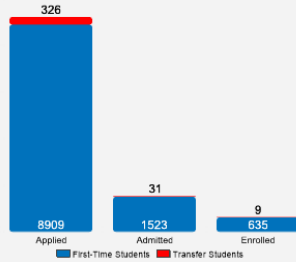

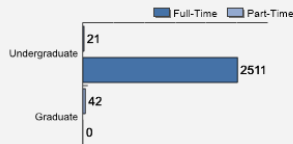


Percentage of Students Who Graduate

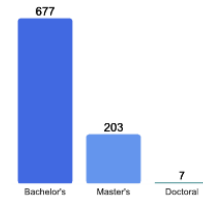

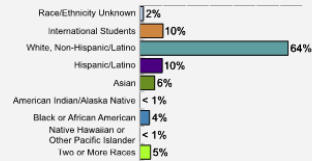
