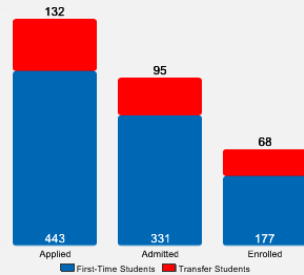

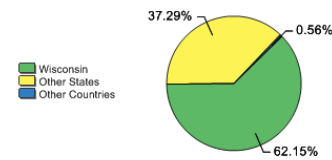

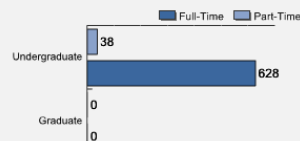


Average High School GPA of Freshman Class: 2.98

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



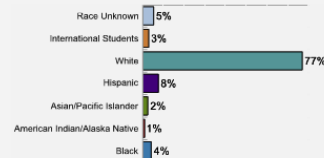

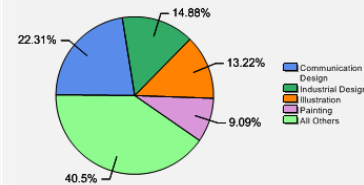

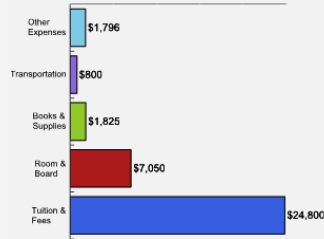

Price of Attendance in 2008-09



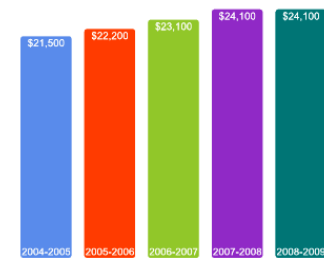
Percent of Freshmen Receiving Aid by Type
