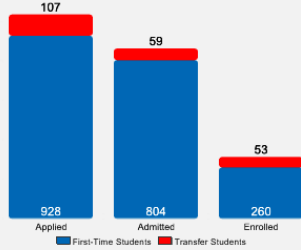

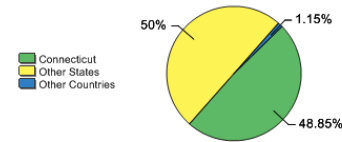

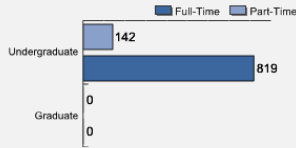

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



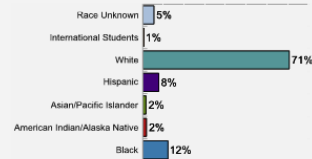

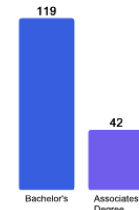
Percentage of Students Who Graduate

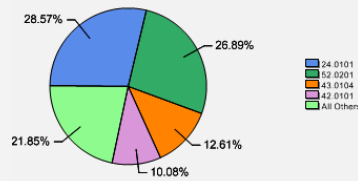

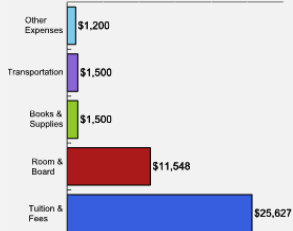

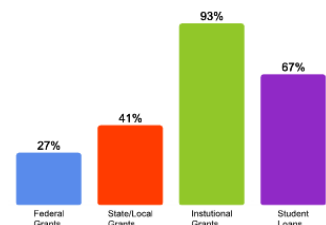

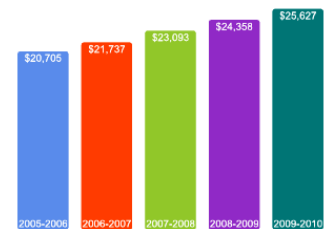
