

About Mount Vernon Nazarene University

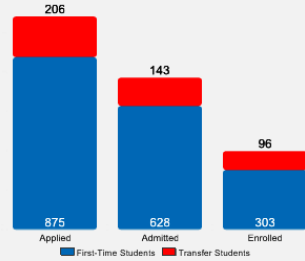

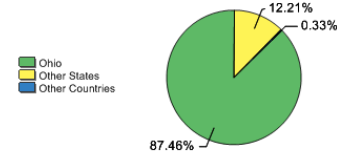

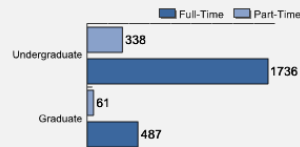
* 99.7% of MVNU first-time freshmen submitted ACT scores, and 19% submitted SAT scores.

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



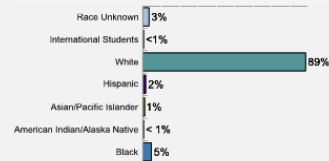

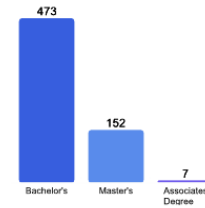
* The 6-year graduation rate for MVNU was 56%. In addition, 83 students (an additional 25%) successfully transferred to other colleges and universities.

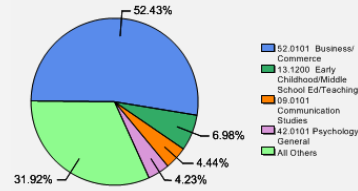

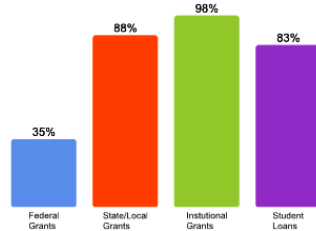

MVNU's total fee for 2009-10 is \$26,380, which includes tuition, room, food service, general fee, and health care. MVNU's tuition for 2008-09 was \$6,500 less than the national average for four-year, private institutions and \$9,400 less when room and board were included.

* Net tuition for each individual student may be lower or higher depending on family income and student eligibility and availability of grant aid.

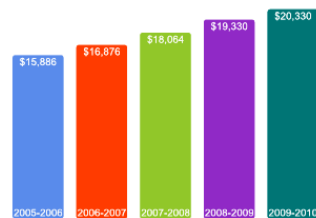
