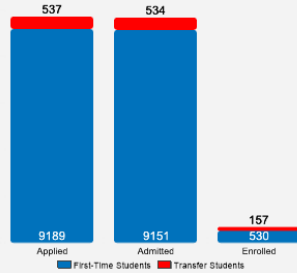

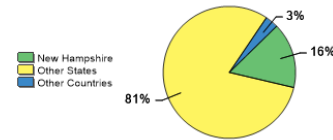

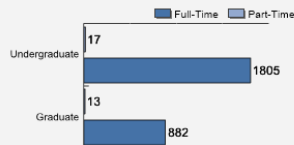

Fall 2017 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



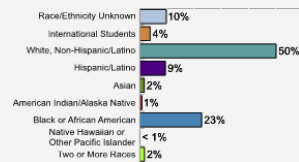
Fall 2017 Enrollment

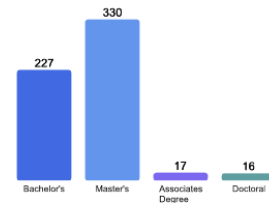

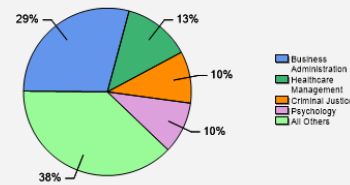

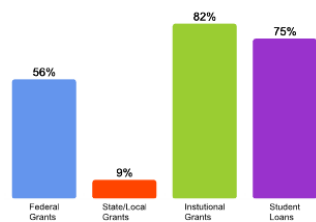

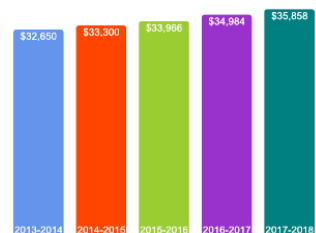
