

About Austin College

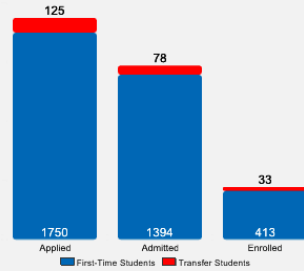

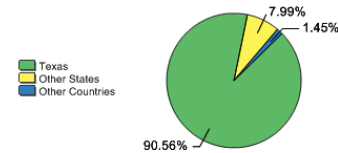

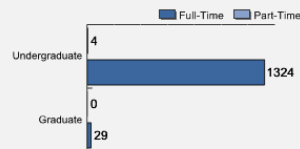

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



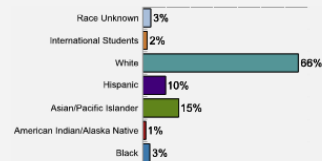

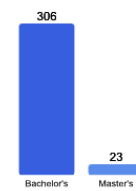

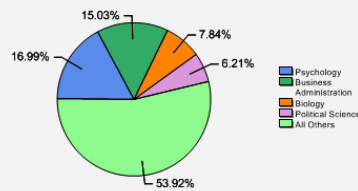

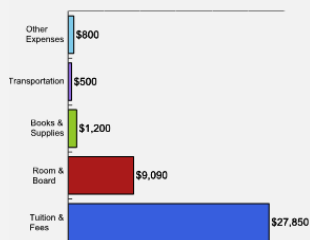

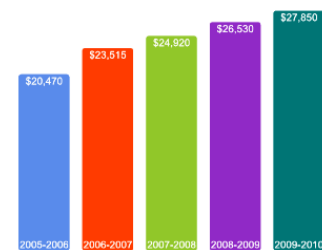
2008 Average Net Tuition for Aided Undergraduates *
