

About Austin College

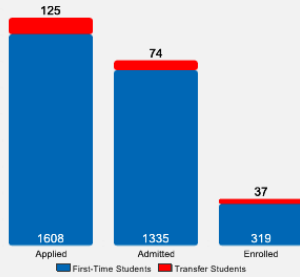

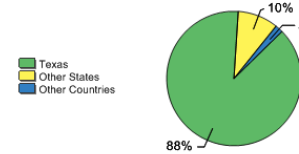

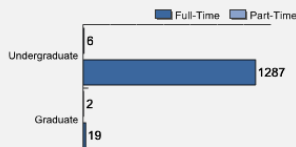

Fall 2010 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



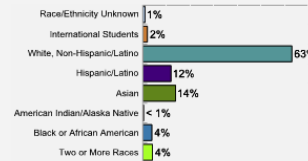
Fall 2010 Enrollment

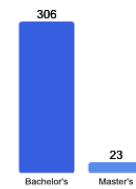

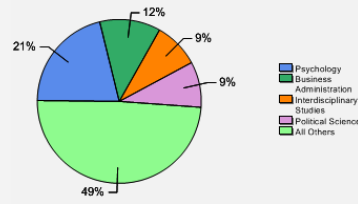

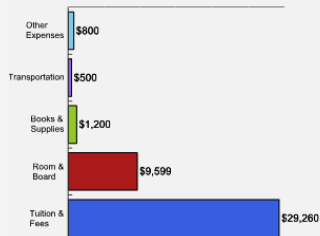

Price of Attendance in 2010-11

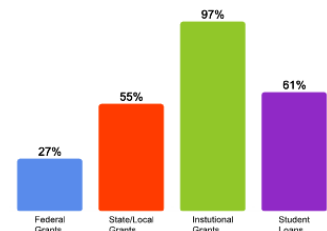


What it's Like on Our Campus

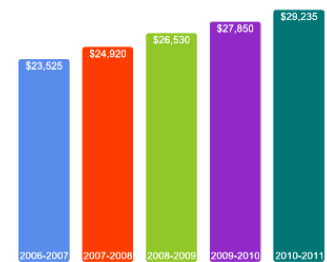
Campus Safety
