

About Pine Manor College

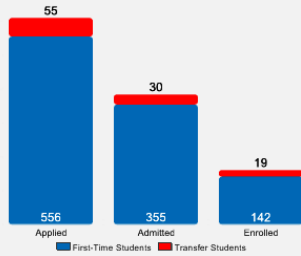

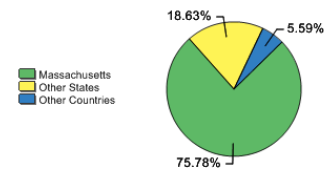

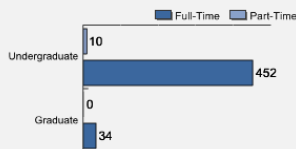


Average High School GPA of Freshman Class: 2.5

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



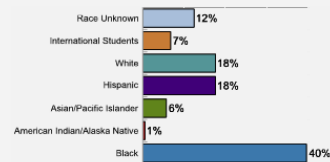
Enrollment

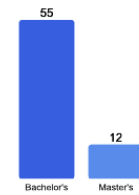

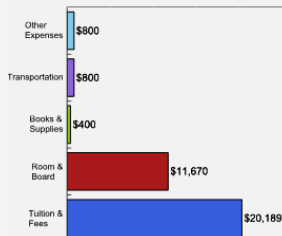

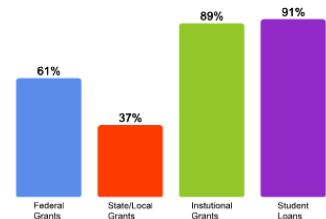
