

About Quinnipiac University

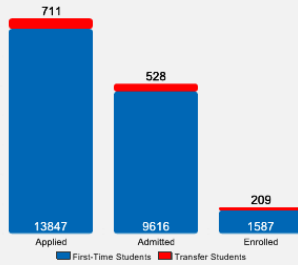

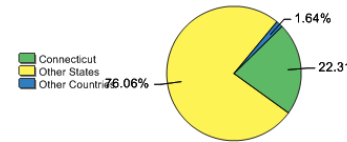

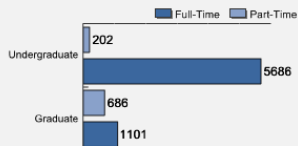

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



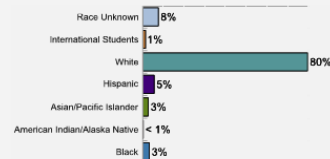

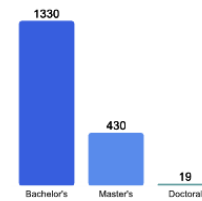

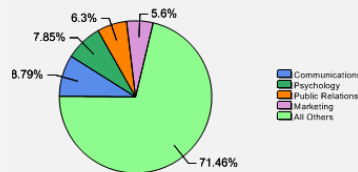

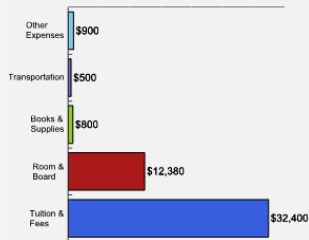

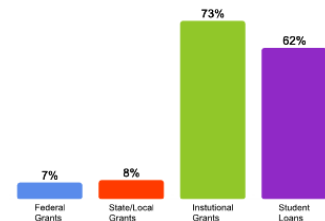

2008 Average Net Tuition for Aided Undergraduates *

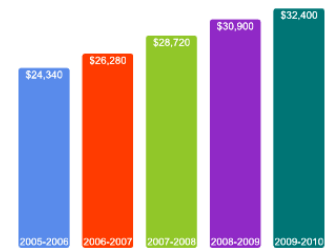
