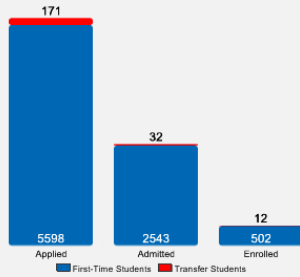

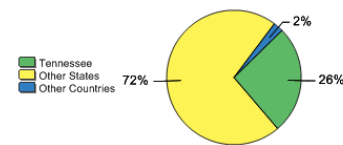

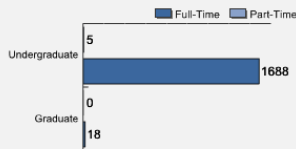

Fall 2010 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



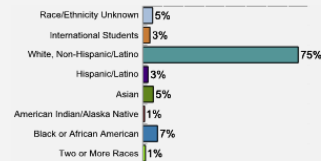
Fall 2010 Enrollment

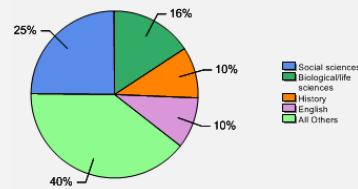

Bachelor's Degrees Awarded Last Year



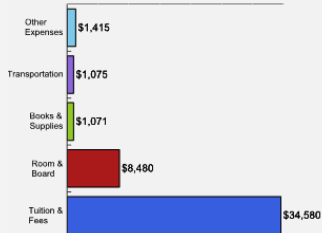

Price of Attendance in 2010-11



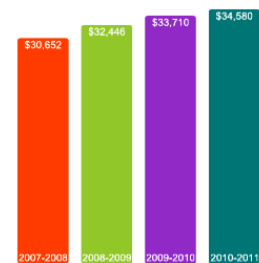
Percent of Freshmen Receiving Aid by Type
