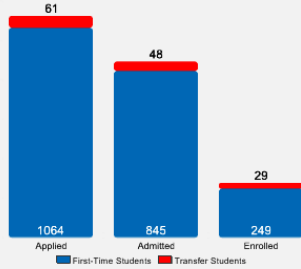

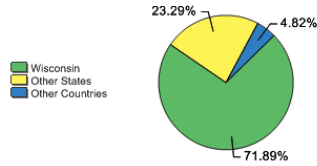

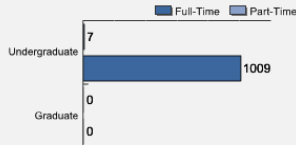

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



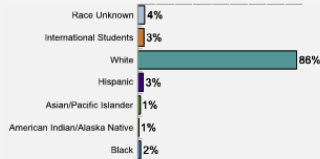

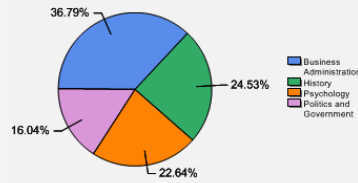

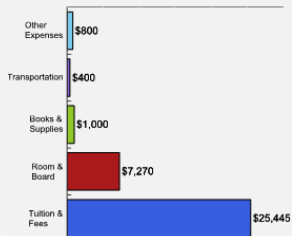

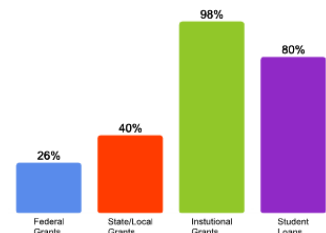


What it's Like on Our Campus

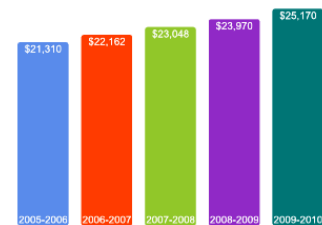
