

About Baldwin-Wallace College

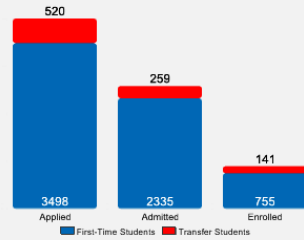

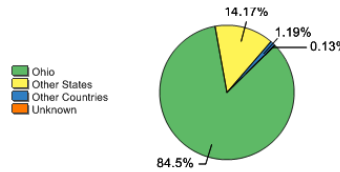

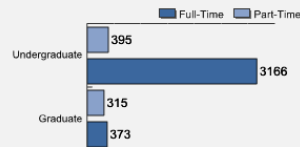

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



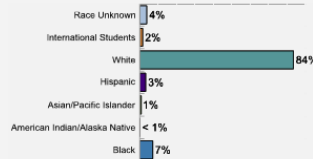

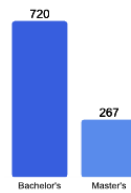

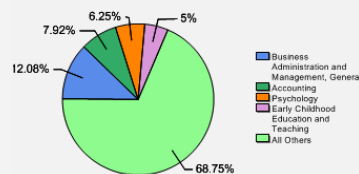

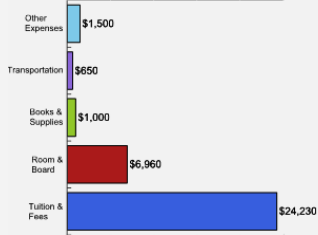

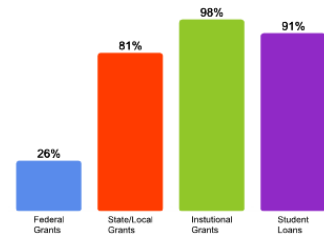

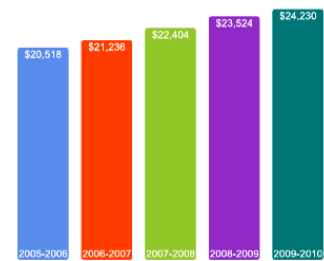
