

About Samford University

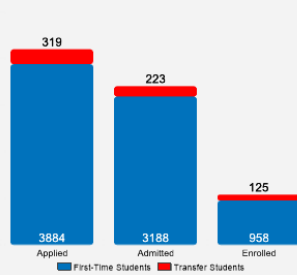

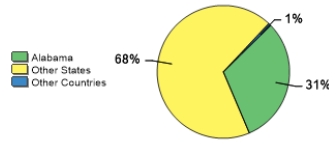

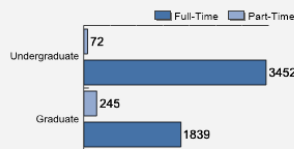

Fall 2018 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



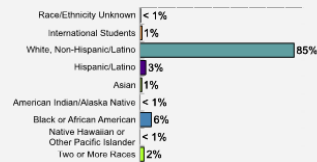
Fall 2018 Enrollment

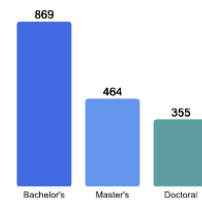

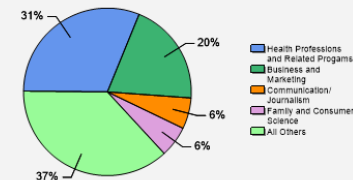

* Minimally, 128 credits are required to successfully complete all Bachelor's degree programs. Few programs require more than 128.

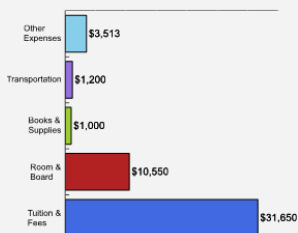

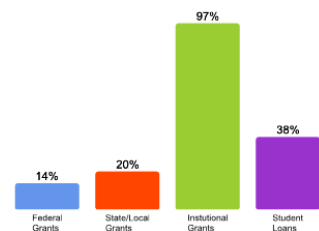

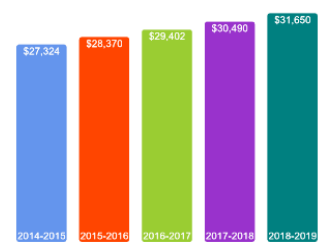
