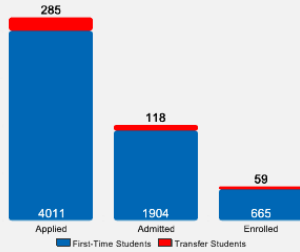

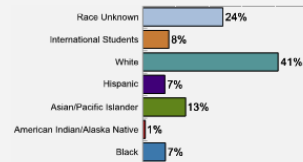

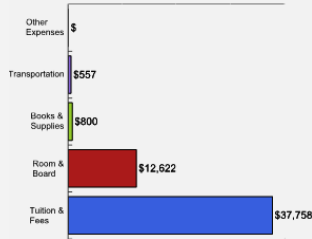

### Price of Attendance in 2009-10



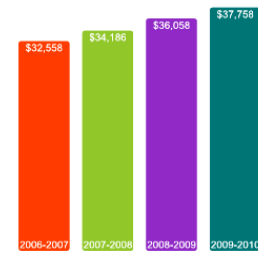
### Percent of Freshmen Receiving Aid by Type
