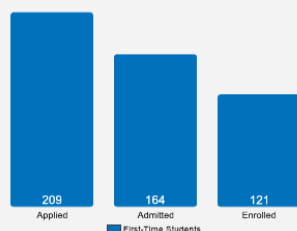

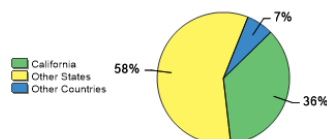

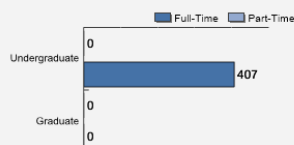

### Fall 2018 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



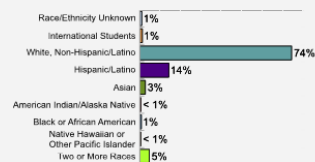
### Fall 2018 Enrollment

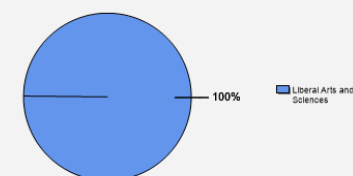

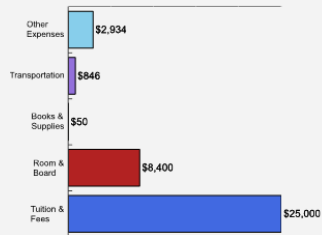

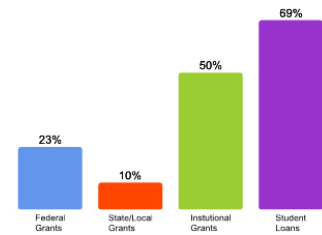

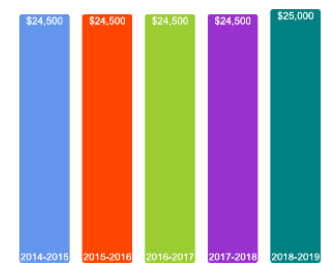
