

## About Bellarmine University

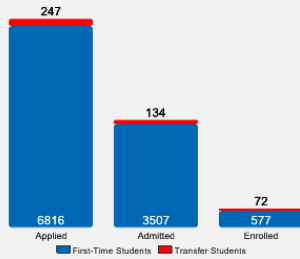

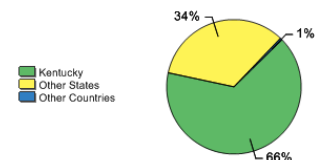

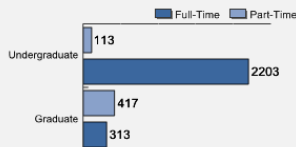

### Fall 2010 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



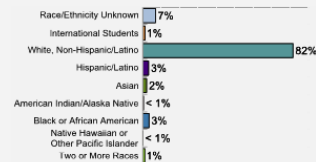
### Fall 2010 Enrollment

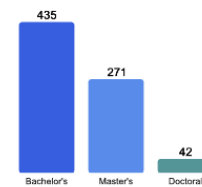

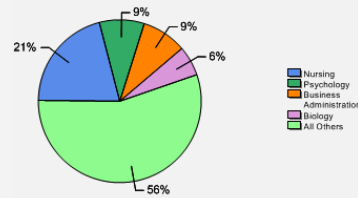

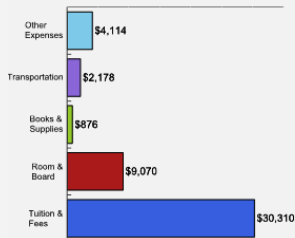

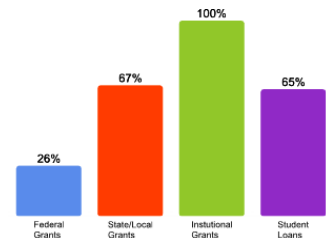


What it's Like on Our Campus

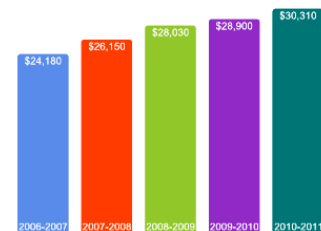
