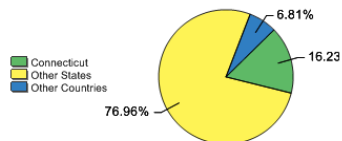

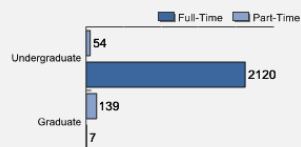

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



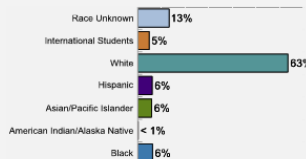

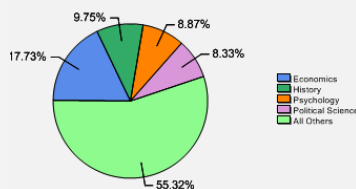

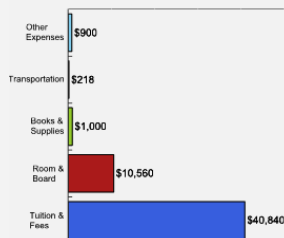

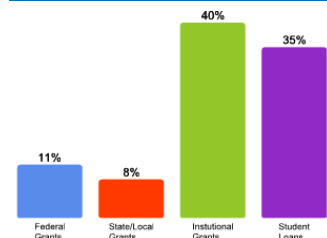

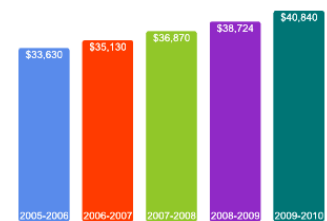
