

## About University of Evansville

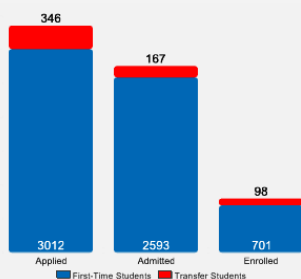

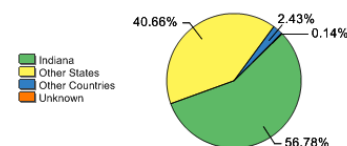

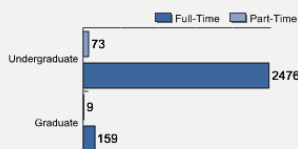

### Freshman Class Geographical Profile



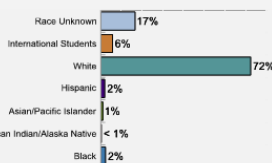

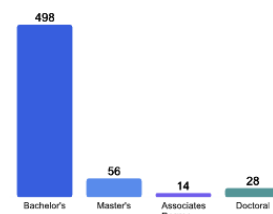

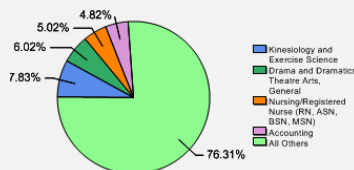

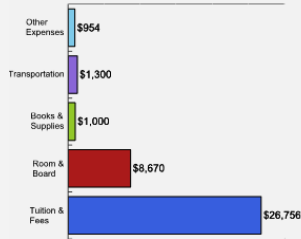

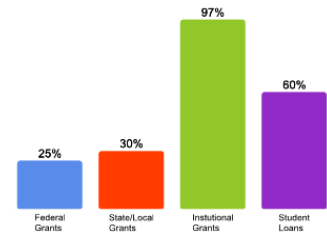

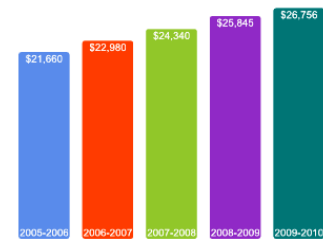
