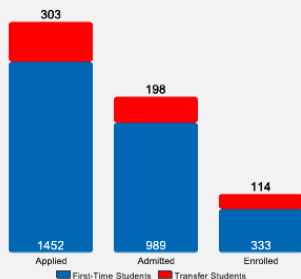

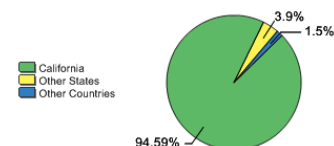

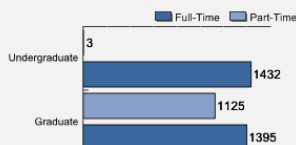

Freshman Class Geographical Profile



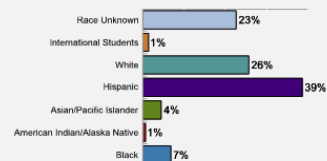

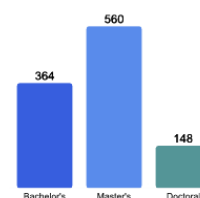

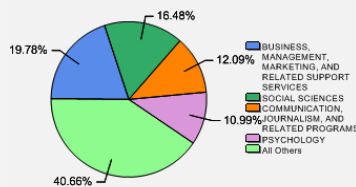

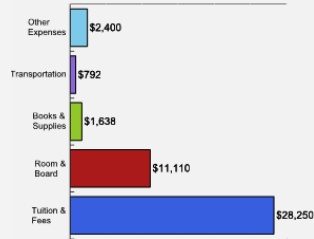

Percent of Freshmen Receiving Aid by Type

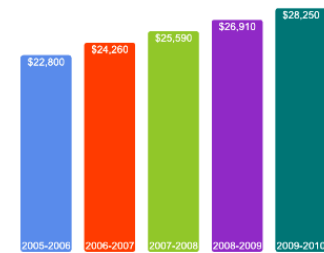
