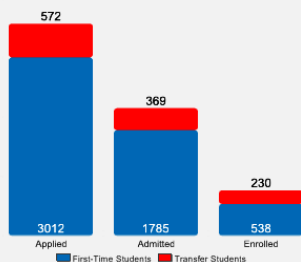

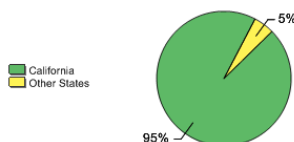

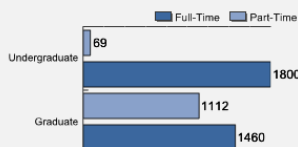

### Fall 2010 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



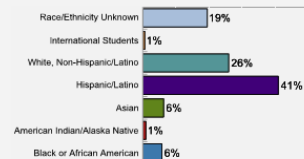
### Fall 2010 Enrollment

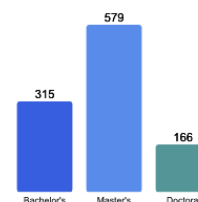

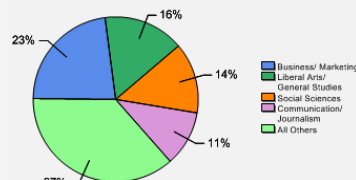

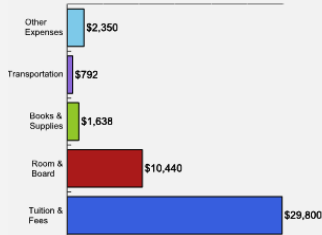

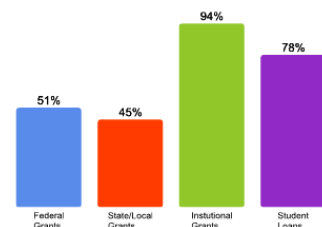

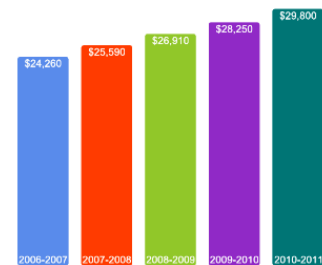
