

## About Wesleyan College

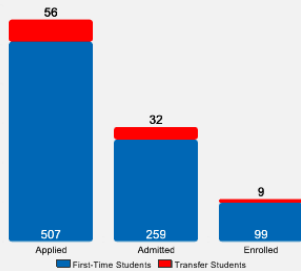

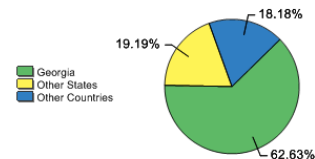

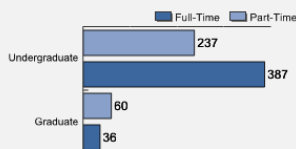

### Freshman Class Geographical Profile



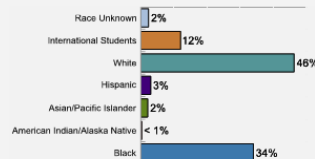

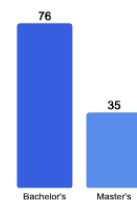

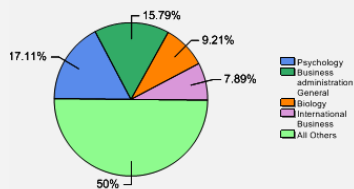

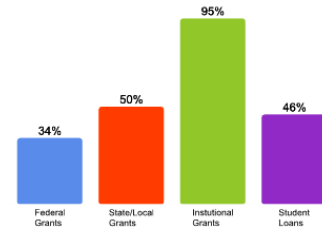

2008 Average Net Tuition for Aided Undergraduates \* **\$3,521**

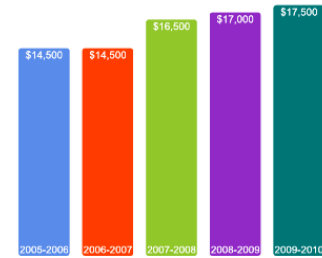
