

About Whitman College

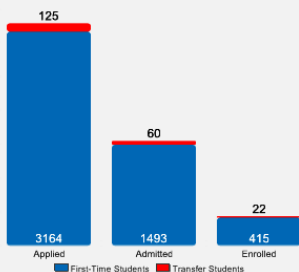

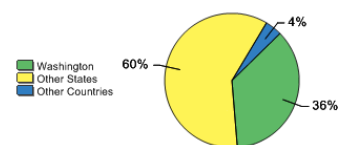

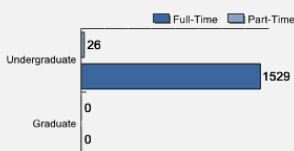

Fall 2010 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



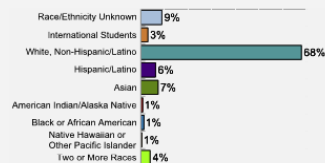
Fall 2010 Enrollment

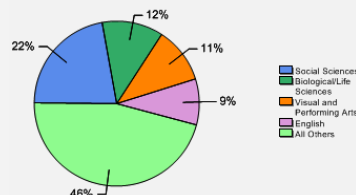

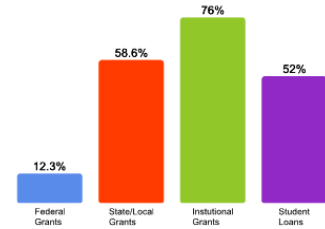


What it's Like on Our Campus

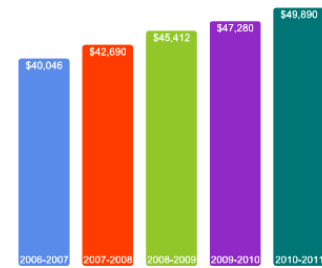
