

**About Whitman College**

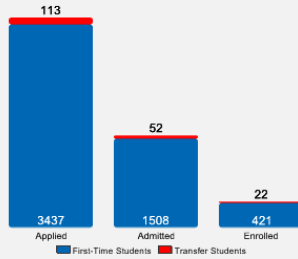

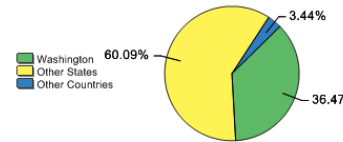

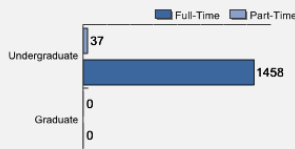

**Freshman Class Geographical Profile**



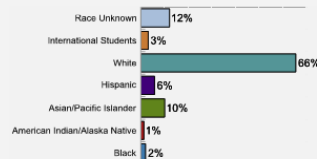

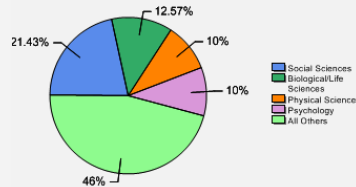

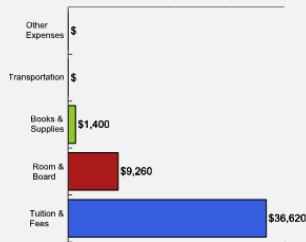

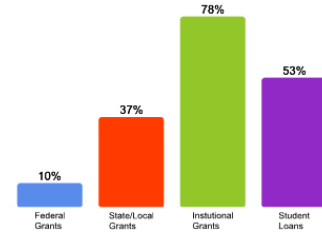

2008 Average Net Tuition for Aided Undergraduates \*

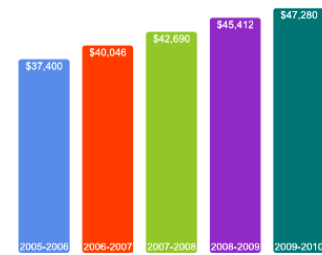
